

The VIKING FF75 Tape Deck is plug-inand-play equipment; ready for immediate use after attaching the temporary mounting brackets which are supplied.

For permanent installations, it is as easily installed as an ordinary record player, and operates equally well when mounted flat or at any degree of slant. A simple, three-position lever controls the tape motion. Calibrations under each tape reel provide for selection of any desired portions of tapes.






Playback head characteristics (also used for recording)

ADAPTABILITY OF THE VERSATILE TAPE DECK TO 4 DESIRABLE METHODS OF OPERATION







WITH BRACKETS REMOVED, MOUNT LIKE A RECORD CHANGER TO ANY DEGREE OF SLANT.

The basic FF75 Tape Deck is adaptable to three distinct modes of operation, Monaural Playback, Binaural Playback and Erase-Record-Playback. With pressure pad and/or tape lifters installed on these three functional adaptations, a total of six separate type numbers is possible.

Three head units, suited for simultaneous recording and monitoring are available on special order.

ORDER BY TYPE NUMBER: Ordering by type number will expedite shipment, and will insure that you receive exactly the merchandise you want.

FF75 MONAURAL PLAYBACK UNIT

This is the basic single head unit for playback of either full track or double track tapes. It is equipped with the single-head bracket.

MONAURAL PLAYBACK UNIT WITH

This is the same as the FF75, except that the accessory tape lifter shown in figure 1 is installed at the factory. This same tapelifter can be added to a FF75 at any time. Pressure pads cannot be used with single head units.

FF75B BINAURAL PLAYBACK UNIT

This unit is equipped with two matched heads on a staggered bracket for playback of either binaural tapes or double track tapes. Two complete amplifier speaker systems are necessary for binaural operation.

FF75B-LP BINAURAL PLAYBACK UNIT WITH TAPELIFTER AND PRESSURE PAD

This is the same as the FF75B except that the accessory tapelifter and pressure pad shown in figure 1 is installed and adjusted at the factory. Use of a tapelifter only is not recommended.



FF75R MONAURAL RECORD-PLAYBACK UNIT

This is the same basic "75" mechanism equipped with an erase head and a single record-playback head. It is capable of recording to the most discriminating of standards and of playback equivalent to that of the standard FF75. No amplifier or erase record circuitry is included.

FF75R-LP MONAURAL RECORD-PLAYBACK WITH TAPELIFTER AND PRESSURE PAD

This is the same as the FF75R except that the tapelifter and pressure pad shown in figure 1 is installed and adjusted at the factory. Use of the pressure pads is recommended for full-fidelity record-playback operation.

Ideal Complement to the VIKING full-fidelity 75 Tape Deck





The VIKING FF75 Tape Deck provides superior performance without special equalization, but it cannot compare with NARTB recorded tapes played through a fully and properly equalized preamplifier and a flat-response music system.

The VIKING PB60 PREAMP is offered as the ideal companion to the FF75 Tape Deck Series. Two controls are provided: a volume level control and a variable equalization control. The volume level control may either be set at a level that does not overload the music system amplifier, or may be used as the system volume control.

The variable equalization control provides for any desired response from 5db above, to 5db below the NARTB response curve at 10,000 cps. Thus the equalization control can, if desired, be used as a tone control with any straight-through, flat amplifier. This eliminates the need for any intermediate mixers, volume and tone controls.

The VIKING PB60 is a thoroughly tested amplifier. Driven by the FF75 playback head from NARTB tapes it provides an output of from 5 to 10 volts from a cathode follower output stage. The effective output impedance is low (400 ohms) permitting long lines to the music system amplifier, without affecting the performance of either the preamplifier or the power amplifier.




